- 3) If we are devoted to the things we attribute value to what might be clues to what we value more than Jesus?
- 4) How is Jesus' reaction to the woman an encouragement to us when we struggle to appreciate the cross?

- 5) If we valued Jesus and his death the way the woman in Matthew 26 does, how might it change:
- Our prayer life?
- Our evangelism?
- Our church family?
- 6) What aspects of the death of Jesus do you find it hardest to understand / appreciate?
- 7) Can you think of practical ways we can prepare for Easter by considering the cross afresh?
