John 17:1-5

- Why is the fact that Jesus prayed important?
- What was significant about this hour that had come?
- What do these verses teach us about Jesus's status?
- How did Jesus want his Father to be glorified?
- How do we respond when under a lot of pressure?
- How does the way Jesus start his prayer provide an example for us?
- How is Jesus's priority different to the worlds?
- What are the results of self love and self glory?
- How do these verses provide an antidote to a self obsessed culture?

John 17:6-19

- What do these verses teach us about Jesus's relationship with the disciples?
- What does he give them?
- Jesus knows he will be physically leaving his disciples soon. What does Jesus pray for his disciples?
- Why do they need protection? John 8:44 John 3:19-20
- Why is it important for us to remember that we are engaged in a spiritual battle?
- If at the critical hour Jesus prioritised praying for the disciples sanctification in the truth how should that impact on our life priorities?
- How should that affect our life together as a church?
- When the world seems against us as Christian's how can we take comfort from this prayer?

- How might this challenge what we think is the most important thing for the church?
