



Hebrews 11:11 - ‘Learning to trust that nothing is too hard for God’

Read Genesis 18:10-15 and 21:1-7 for Sarah’s story.

1) Nothing is too hard when it comes to God’s promises

- What does Sarah’s story teach us about God?
- On Sunday we thought of some other instances where God similarly did ‘the impossible’ as he keeps his promise. Can you think of other times in the Bible where we see this too?
- Can you think of circumstances today, either in the world or in our lives, where things feel ‘impossible’. What does Sarah’s story encourage us to do as we think of these?

2) Faith is a gift that grows

- We see in Genesis 18 that Sarah’s faith is not perfect and appears shaky to start with. How is her inclusion in Hebrews 11 an encouragement to us and what does it teach us about faith?
- What does Hebrews 11:11 tell us is the basis of Sarah’s faith? How can we apply that to ourselves?
- Are there specific times you have grown in your trust in God’s promises (and that nothing is too hard for him)?
- What most encourages you from Sarah’s story?
