1 Peter 1:13-2:3

- Look through this passage trying to spot how the presently realities of a Christian's status and hope relate to the instructions about how to live. How do these fit together?
- What roles do our minds, our hearts, and our wills have in these instructions?
- How does our hope (v13) help us to live godly lives?
- How does our status as children of God help us to live godly lives (v14)?
- How does the forgiveness of Christ (vv18-21) help us to live godly lives?
- Why is a loving community (v22) important for godly living?
- What does it mean to "crave pure spiritual milk" and how does this help us?
- Tell the group examples of who these insights have helped you or others in the past.
- Which instruction in this passage do you most need to respond to? How will you do that?
- The final call in the sermon was "don't work harder, work smarter". What might that look like for you?

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
