- 1. You're praying for a particular person that God would give you an opportunity to speak to them about Jesus, what confidence do you have that your efforts, when the opportunity opens, will amount to any good? See Ps. 2:8; Rom. 15:8-12; Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8.
- 2. How often do we feel that the enemies of sin and the devil are our biggest enemies? Do you agree that we, in England, are more prone to think of our physical problems as most important? How bad would it be if we lost the fight of *faith*? 1 Pet. 5:8
- 3. You're having a rubbish day at work, or at home, but you know that your attitude is not honouring to Jesus, how does knowing God has given you his powerful Holy Spirit help at this time? See Rom. 8:13; 15:13.
- 4. The Psalm writer praises God for his power, but someone might say to you "It's dangerous for God to have this unlimited power"; what do you say in return?
- 5. God is using his mighty power now to bring us to glory, how does this help in times of trial? See Rom. 8:28
